Dear Parents,

As we head into cold and flu season, we wanted to send a reminder about procedures for student absences and/or students signing out due to illness.

In event your child is ill or absent, good communication is always imperative, and we greatly appreciate you emailing your student's teacher(s); however, it is also important to call the school office when your child will be out of school. In some cases (for instance, a sub in the room), the message that your child is absent does not reach the office, and we are unaware of the contact you have initiated.

Also, if your child is absent for more than one day, you may request work. These requests should be made by 9:00 a.m. and will be ready to be picked up at 3:00 p.m. Unfortunately, we cannot send work home with another student. Students will have the same number of days to make up the work as the days they were absent.

Finally, if your child becomes ill while at school, he or she needs to see the school nurse. The school nurse will notify you, and, if the nurse believes the child should be sent home, the absence will be excused. Recently, we have had some students call or text parents from their cell phones to pick them up early due to illness. Please understand, if the child is not excused by the nurse, the absence will be counted as unexcused. Additionally, we would greatly appreciate your assistance in helping us to enforce our cell phone policy at school by reminding your child that cell phones are only to be used with teacher permission.


1,600 pairs of shoes by February 1st!!


